Dry stall

No care included. Owner provides and feeds out their own hay and grain. Misty Step wheelbarrows, pitchforks, brooms, shovels, and facilities (e.g. crossies) are available for your use.

Stall and Care - Includes:

- Stall cleaning once per day
- Hay as needed for the horse, delivered up to 5 times daily.
- Grain delivered up to 3 times daily
- Free choice water at all times

Owner provides individually bagged and labelled grain meals. The bags or supplementary tupperware should include all feed, supplements, and medications that can be mixed with food. Staff will deliver the feed at breakfast lunch and/or dinner. Feed times are approximately 7:30am, noon, and 4:00pm.

A second cut orchard grass and western alfalfa hays are available . If preferred, owner can bring their own hay and leave a bale or two in the space allotted for that horse. Any personal belongings that will be left at the barn (trunk, boots, blankets, fly gear, etc) also must fit in that space. Space for tack can be provided with advanced notice.

Many basic care veterinary materials are available and freely provided, if discussed with staff or Dr Boger. Any medications that the horse needs that can not be mixed into a meal, may or may not be able to be given by staff and need to be discussed with Dr. Boger.

Day Board Contract

Horse Owner Understands and Agrees to these terms:

- The contracted service terms above.
- There are inherent risks associated with directly or indirectly engaging in equine activities. For the purposes of this agreement, engaging in equine activities includes all aspects of interaction with horses and/or livestock to include but not limited to a person who walks among/is around, is a spectator, feeds, grooms, waters, shoes, cleans stalls/barn, inspects, provides care for, rides, trains, drives or is a passenger upon an equine, mounted or unmounted. These risks include but are not limited to serious accidents, injury, disability and even the possibility of death. Horse Owner, on behalf of him/herself and on behalf of his/her estate, heirs, agents, friends, relatives, acquaintances, guests, or anybody claiming any rights deriving from Horse Owner agrees to and hereby does assume all risks associated with any equine activities including but not limited to those stated above, and further waives the right to sue for any accident, injury, disability or death occurring directly or indirectly in connection with equine activities.
- Horse Owner agrees to hold Misty Step Stables and the owners, members, employees, and agents, harmless from any and all claims relating to or arising out of any damage, injury, or death caused by Horse Owner's horse to anyone and agrees to pay any legal fees, and/or expenses incurred by Misty Step Stables in defense of such claim. Horse Owner must sign the Misty Step Stables liability waiver and is responsible for having any and all guests that accompany the Horse Owner sign the same liability waiver. Waivers will be made available. Horse Owner agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Misty Step Stables, the owners, members, employees, and agents from any and all claims relating to or arising out of any damage, injury, or death to any such guest that has not signed the liability waiver.
- Horse Owner further understands and agrees that they will not hold Misty Step Stables, nor the owners, members, employees, or agents responsible for any disease, illness, injury, disability or death sustained by their horse(s), themselves, their agents, friends, relatives, acquaintances, or guests caused directly or indirectly, in whole or in part, by water, flood, electricity, snow, ice hail, fire, building structure default, wind, noise, equipment, act of carelessness, negligence, vandalism, misjudgment or any Act of God, or by any act of any third party.
- Horse Owner understands that Misty Step Stables and the owners, members, employees, or agents will not be liable for any injury to the horse(s) or damage to any property should the boarded horse(s) escape from any enclosure.
- Owner agrees to pay the day board fee in full before the end of the first day of day board. A late fee of \$25.00 per day may be charged after that time
- Horse Owner understands that keeping personal property, such as tack, equipment, feed, cars or horse trailers, at any equestrian facility, including that of Misty Step Stables, is inherently risky and that keeping personal property in a shared tack room is particularly risky. Accordingly, Horse Owner agrees to hold Misty Step Stables and the owners, members, employees, and agents harmless for loss of or damage to Horse Owner's property.
- Horse Owner gives permission for the owners of Misty Step Stables to call the above designated Veterinarian(s) and/or farrier if, in the opinion of Misty Step Stables, the boarded horse(s) requires treatment due to accident, injury, disease or illness. If the designated Veterinarian(s) is/are not available or cannot be contacted, Misty Step Stables will contact our Veterinarian (Dr. Anna Boger) or any other that can respond. Misty Step Stables will first take reasonable steps to contact and inform the Horse Owner or emergency contact that a call to the Veterinarian will be made. Horse Owner understands and agrees that all services performed by the attending Veterinarian will be at the Horse Owner's expense and that extra charges may be added to the Board Fee if extra medical attention or care is requested to be performed by Misty Step Stables

staff.

- For safety reasons, Horse Owner understands and agrees that their dog(s) are only allowed on the premises on a case-by-case basis, with written express permission from Misty Step Stables. In addition, Horse Owner, their agents, friends, relatives, or acquaintances will honor all safety rules adopted by Misty Step Stables and “No Smoking” areas to include all barns and outbuildings.
